

Oberon Community Services Committee Charter

Appointment and delegations

Council established the Committee as a §355 Committee at its Ordinary Meeting on February 21 2012.

The Committee has been delegated the following powers and responsibilities;

- a) Act as liaison between Council and the community user groups associated with the Library, the CTC and the Community Centre
- b) To discuss and advise Council on the development of non sporting community facilities services and policy
- c) To participate in Oberon Council long-range planning with regards non community sporting facilities
- d) To make recommendations to Council regarding the Library, CTC and the Community Centre

Note

- I. The Committee DOES NOT have any authority to incur any expenditure on Councils behalf other than that which is to be met from the Committees own funds or from funds voted by Council for that purpose.
- II. The Committee is covered by the Councils Public Liability Insurance for any action taken within the ambit of the authority delegated by Council.
- III. Members of the Committee when carrying out voluntary work are covered by an accident policy taken out by Council in respect of voluntary workers.

Membership

Council will resolve the membership by way of resolution and the appointments are made for the term of the current council.
