

Bulky waste Collection 17th October – 21st October

Who is the service for?

All Oberon Council domestic residence within the Town Improvement area, excluding Albion Street from Hazelgrove Road, On-Avon Ave, Shakespeare Close, Midsummer Avenue & McMahons Court.

When does the collection happen?

The collection will take place from Monday 17th Oct 2022 until Friday 21st October 2022, if you have your normal weekly garbage is collected on Wednesdays, please make sure your rubbish is out on the kerb side by Sunday, if your normal weekly garbage is collected on Fridays, please place your items are on the kerb side by Wednesday ready for collection.

Where do I put my bulky waste items?

All items are to be placed neatly next to the edge of the kerb and please make sure the items are not blocking any pedestrian access.

All waste must be separated into 4 separate piles

Scrap Metal and White Goods General Bulky Waste Bundled Organics E-Waste Any loose items & organics must be tied securely with rope or string (not wire), into bundles or contained in sturdy boxes. Please secure all items to avoid Windblown littering.

How much can I put out?

The total volume of waste presented for collection must not exceed 2 cubic metres.

Acceptable items

Scrap Metal & White Goods Collection

All metal items collected will be recycled. Please ensure all doors are removed from household appliances and white goods.

Acceptable items include:

- Fridges
- Washing Machines
- Stoves & Microwaves
- Metal Lawn Mowers
- Wheel Barrows
- Empty Paint Tins
- Barbecues
- Pushbikes
- Hot Water Systems
- Metal Furniture

General Bulky Waste Collection

Acceptable items include:

- Mattresses
- Floor coverings (small room ONLY)
- Furniture
- Vacuum Cleaners
- Lounges
- Small Appliances
- Bric-a-brac

Bundled Organics

Acceptable items include:

- Garden pruning's Untreated timber
- Tree limbs no longer than 1.8 metres and 250mm in diameter

E-Waste Collection

Acceptable items include:

- Televisions / Computer Monitors
- CD / DVD Players
- Printers / Scanners & keyboards
- Mobile phones / walkie talkies
- Laptops & Computer towers
- Smoke Detectors
- Power Tools (240V Handheld & Benchtop)

Unacceptable items

The following materials will NOT be collected:

- Materials that exceed the maximum dimensions of 2 cubic metres
- Asbestos, fibro and insulation batts
- Trade, industrial and shop waste
- Cement bags and sawdust
- Motor vehicles, engines, car parts and tyres
- Building and demolition materials, concrete, bricks, tiles, fencing, plumbing fixtures and panes of glass
- Large carpet rolls
- Gas bottles and fire extinguishers
- Hazardous waste such as paint, solvents, chemicals, cleaners, unwanted medicines and batteries
- Liquids of any sort including fuels and oils

- Material suitable for placement in your mobile garbage bins, food scraps and household garbage
- Small machinery containing fuel or oil including oil heaters
- Large tree trunks and thorny bushes
- Soil and stones



The Council has the right to reject any material that they consider unacceptable.
