RE: Notification Big Plain Hazard Reduction Burn – Friday 12 April 2019

NPWS will be conducting a hazard reduction burn in the southern Blue Mountains National Park and Kanangra Boyd National Park starting at 9:30 hrs on Friday 12th April 2019. Ignition will be completed using aerial incendiary and operations may continue through until Monday 15th April 2019.

The burn block is located 14 kilometres west of Yerranderie in a location known as Big Plain. The burn block is bounded by the Kowmung River to the north, Waterfall Creek to the east, Oberon-Colong Stock Route to the south and Ruby creek to the west. The Kowmung river section is between Moola Point and Black Snake Bend. For details visit website www.nationalparks.nsw.gov.au

The Oberon-Colong stock route will remain open to traffic, however drivers are reminded to drive to the conditions.

The burn area will remain closed to all visitors until Monday 29th April 2019. The closures will remain in place unless otherwise extended or removed.
