BORG PANELS OBERON PROJECT UPDATE.

Dear Community member,

We have been made aware that some members of the community have raised concerns with Council over the last few weeks regarding the Borg Panels site. Hence, we have prepared the following statement regarding the Borg Panels development, its progress over the past 18 months and the proposed activities over the next 6 months.

The project has progressed well since its approval in May 2017 with nearly all areas of the project complete and checked for safety late December 2018. Since the site returned, after the Christmas break, to operational status the amenity of the surrounding areas has changed. You will be hearing noises that were previously unheard and notice the new stacks around the project which have begun to emit steam and vapour. Please be assured this is a normal part of commissioning new plant and equipment. Borg remains committed to ensuring the next phase of the development doesn't impact the town and its people significantly.

During this period you may also notice increased Borg staff activity throughout the town as part of the routine environmental compliance checks and investigation into community concerns.

The unusual noises and activities will reduce as commissioning progresses and once complete there will be minimal change to the amenity of the surrounding environment.
