



Temporary Road and Street Closures for Events

1. Intent of Policy

To provide Council with a mechanism to control and regulate temporary street and road closures in the Oberon Council area.

2. Scope of Policy

This policy applies to all applications to undertake events in the Oberon Council area that require temporary road and street closures.

Relevant Statutory Requirements specific to the policy:

Local Government Act, 1993

Roads Act, 1993

3. Guidelines

Council prefers to be notified of all events occurring in the area to facilitate promotion.

Council will consider granting approval for temporary road closures only when written application is made to Council. Applications must be submitted a minimum of two months prior to the proposed closure.

Council may approve temporary road closure for community and tourism events

Council generally will not approve closure of Council roads for car rallies. Council has no objection to the conduct of touring road events through the Oberon Council area, provided appropriate consent is granted from NSW Police.

The Director of Engineering will consider the purpose of relevant legislation and issues prior to issuing approval for a temporary road closure.

The application may need to be referred to the Traffic Committee of Council.

The Director of Engineering and/or the Traffic Committee may impose any condition on the approval to ensure the safety, amenity of the area and minimum traffic or parking disruption.
